

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### FAST FINISH SLOTS TOURNAMENT

**Promoter:** The Promoter is The Star Entertainment Qld Limited ABN 78 010 741 045 trading as Treasury Brisbane, 159 William Street, Brisbane QLD 4001 ph. (07) 3306 8888 ("**Treasury**").

#### Tournament Period

1. The Fast Finish Slots Tournament ("**Tournament**") will commence at 19:00:00 on Friday 2 February 2018 and conclude at 18:00:00 on Sunday 25 February 2018 ("**Tournament Period**") at Treasury. All times listed are in Australian Eastern Standard time.
2. Random selection draws will take place on the Ground Floor or in The Suite Ground Floor at Treasury ("**Tournament Location**") between 19:00:00 and 22:00:00 on the 2, 9, 16 and 23 February 2018 and between 15:00:00 and 18:00:00 on the 4, 11, 18 and 25 February 2018 (each day "**Random Selection Period**"). A total of fifty (50) random selection draws will be conducted at each Random Selection Period during the Promotional Period (each a "**Random Selection Draw**").

#### Participation requirements

3. Participation in the Tournament is open to persons who:
  - a. are 18 years of age or older;
  - b. are Members of The Star Club program operated by the Promoter and that have a current membership card (each a "**Membership Card**");
  - c. are entitled to access the Tournament Location;
  - d. are not the subject of an exclusion direction or self-exclusion order pursuant to the Casino Control Act 1982 (Qld); and
  - e. are not the subject of a Withdrawal of Licence (WOL) from The Star Gold Coast or Treasury Brisbane.

People who meet the above criteria are referred to as "**Eligible Entrants**" and will be entitled to participate in the Tournament.

#### Entry into the Random Selection Draws

4. To be eligible to participate in the Tournament an Eligible Entrant must be playing a compatible electronic gaming machine or electronic table game (each an "**Eligible Machine**") at a Tournament Location during a Random Selection Period.
5. To be deemed to be playing an Eligible Machine, an Eligible Entrant must be playing at the Eligible Machine and have their Membership Card inserted and credit available at the moment the Konami Casino Management System recognises the "Random Giveaway".

#### Random Selection Draws

6. During each Random Selection Period Random Selection Draws will occur at the discretion of the Promoter using the "Random Giveaway" function in the Konami Casino Management System. The time of each Random Selection Draw has been predetermined by the Promoter. At each Random Selection Draw the Promoter will select ten (10) Eligible Machines (each a "**Selected Machine**").
7. If the Eligible Entrant playing the Selected Machine satisfies the Conditions of Entry they will be deemed a contestant ("**Contestant**") for that relevant Tournament heat ("**Tournament Heat**"), and that Contestant will receive a message on the screen of the Selected Machine they are playing notifying them that they were chosen. The first name and Membership Card number of each Contestant will be announced at the Tournament Location in the order in which the Contestant were drawn.
8. If a Contestant does not satisfy **Condition 7, 24 or 25** or does not otherwise satisfy these Conditions of Entry, redraws will take place until a Contestant who satisfy the requirements of these Conditions of Entry is drawn for each of the relevant Random Selection Draw.

9. The Promoter cannot guarantee that all announcements can be heard in all parts of the Tournament Location.

### Tournament Heats

10. Contestants must present themselves to a representative of the Promoter at Tournament Location within three (3) minutes of their name being announced and confirm their identity in accordance with **Conditions 24 or 25**.
11. For each Tournament Heat, Contestants will be allocated to a Tournament electronic gaming machine (“**Device**”) by order in to which they were drawn.
12. All Contestants must participate in the Tournament Heat as designated by the Promoter.
13. If the Promoter deems that any of the Devices is malfunctioning and requires removal from the Tournament, the Promoter reserves the right to remove the Device from the Tournament.
14. A Contestant in a Tournament Heat is unable to complete the specified period of play due to the removal of a Device in accordance with **Condition 13**, the Contestant will be provided with another sixty (60) seconds of play on another allocated Device to determine that Contestant’s score for their Tournament Heat (as applicable).
15. There will be five (5) Tournament Heats conducted (with a maximum of ten (10) Contestants in each heat) during the Tournament Period.
16. The Contestant playing in the Tournament Heat will have the opportunity to register a score (“**Score**”) by playing on their allocated Device for a period of sixty (60) seconds in their allocated Device.
17. If any two (2) or more Contestants have a tied Score at the end of their Tournament Heat which would affect the allocation of their place in their Tournament Heat, there will be a sixty (60) second play-off on allocated Devices between those two (2) or more Contestants (a “**Play-Off**”). Devices will be allocated to the Contestants in a Play-Off in the order in which they competed in their Tournament Heat.
18. If any two (2) or more Contestants have a tied score as the result of a Play-Off, further Play-Offs will be held between those Contestants with a tied Score until those Contestants register different Scores. The Score achieved by Contestants in a Play-Off will only be used to determine the ranking of the Scores of those Contestants as between themselves for their place in their Tournament Heat.
19. The winner of the Tournament Heat will be the Contestant with the highest Score after sixty (60) seconds of play in the Tournament Heat (or any Play-Off’s in accordance with **Condition 17 and 18**).

### Prizes

20. The Contestants will, in accordance to the ranking of the Scores at the conclusion of the Tournament Heat or at the end of any Play-Offs needed in the event of tied Scores, receive the following (each a “**Winner**”):

Third place	\$100 cash
Fourth and fifth place	\$ 50 cash
Sixth place	\$50 Food & Beverage Credit
Seventh place	\$25 Food & Beverage Credit
Eighth to tenth place	\$20 Slots Dollars

(each a “**Prize**”).

21. The \$50 Food and Beverage Credit Prize will be added to the Winners Comp Point balance by a representative of the Promoter after each Tournament Heat. Food & Beverage Credit Prizes are not transferable and may become unavailable due to technical difficulties outside of our control.
22. The Slots Dollars Prizes will be added by the representative of the Promoter after each Tournament Heat to the Winners Slots Dollars balance. These Slots Dollars are not transferable. Slots Dollars may become unavailable due to technical difficulties outside of our control. Slots Dollars are valid thirty (30) days from the day they have been awarded.

23. The total prize pool for the Tournament is \$45,400 in cash, Slots Dollars and Food and Beverage Credits (“Prize Pool”).

## Identification

24. A Contestant must produce valid acceptable identification to a representative of the Promoter to confirm their eligibility to win a prize. Valid identification acceptable to the Promoter will be either one form of valid photographic identification (Passport or Australian driver’s licence) with an undamaged clearly visible photograph, or two other forms of non-photographic identification acceptable to the Promoter.
25. The Promoter reserves the right to waive or vary the identification requirements at its sole discretion in circumstances where the identity of a Contestant is determinable by a representative of the Promoter without the assistance of these or any other form of identification.

## General

49. Directors, management and employees of The Star Entertainment Group of companies (including any related body corporate as defined in the Corporations Act 2001) and their immediate families are not eligible to participate in this Tournament. For the purposes of this clause, ‘immediate families’ of an employee means the person’s spouse and family members residing at the same premises as the employee. The Star Entertainment Group comprises, but is not limited to the businesses of The Star Sydney, The Star Gold Coast and Treasury Brisbane.
50. Prizes must be taken as stated and cannot be exchanged or redeemed for alternate prizes. Any tax liability or implication which attaches to a prize is the responsibility of the Member claiming that prize.
51. The Promoter is not responsible for any loss, damage or injury suffered or claimed (including, but not limited to, indirect or consequential loss or damage, personal injury or death, and direct or indirect loss or damage) by an entrant in relation to entering or participating in this Tournament or taking or using the prizes offered except where that loss, damage or injury was caused by breach of these terms and conditions by the Promoter or the wilful or negligent acts or omissions of the Promoter.
52. Conduct of the entire Tournament, including decisions on the eligibility of persons to enter and validity of entry and prizes, shall be the responsibility of the Promoter.
53. To the extent that a situation or issue arises for which these terms and conditions make no provision or in relation to which the relevant terms and conditions are unclear, the Promoter reserves the right to decide regarding such situation or issue which is not inconsistent with these terms and conditions.
54. While the Promoter intends to conduct the Tournament as offered, the Promoter reserves the right to cancel or change the Tournament or a prize offered in the Tournament if it can no longer continue the Tournament or offer a prize due to circumstances outside the Promoter’s control.
55. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for late or non-received entries. The Promoter does not guarantee the continuous or fault-free operation of the entry processes, including entry validating and receipting processes, during the Tournament.
56. Any entrant who tampers, or attempts to tamper, with the entry processes or tampers, or attempts to tamper with the processes used for the Tournament or who submits an entry which is not valid in accordance with these terms will be subject to disqualification at the discretion of the Promoter.
57. Winners may be asked to participate in publicity or advertising at the request of the Promoter. Participation in any such publicity or advertising is at the sole discretion of the relevant Eligible Member. The names of Winners will not be published without their consent except as announced at the Tournament Location.
58. Participation in the Tournament indicates acceptance of the terms and conditions governing the Tournament. These terms and conditions will be available at The Star Club Desk or at the VIP Services Desk throughout the Tournament Period.
59. By participating in this Tournament, the information provided by an entrant to the Promoter becomes the property of the Promoter and may be used for the Promoter’s business analysis and marketing purposes in

accordance with the Promoter's privacy statement which can be viewed at [www.treasurybrisbane.com.au](http://www.treasurybrisbane.com.au). Privacy law allows Members to access their personal information held by the Promoter in certain circumstances. Failure to supply the personal information requested may result in an entry being deemed invalid.
