

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

PLATINUM SLOTS TOURNAMENT

Promoter: The Promoter is The Star Entertainment Qld Limited ABN 78 010 741 045 trading as Treasury Brisbane, 159 William Street, Brisbane QLD 4001 ph. (07) 3306 8888 ("**Treasury**").

Tournament Period

1. The Platinum Slots Tournament ("**Tournament**") will commence at 18:00:00 on Monday 7 August, 2017 and conclude at 21:00:00 on Monday 28 August, 2017 ("**Tournament Period**") at Treasury. All times listed are in Australian Eastern Standard time.
2. The Tournament will consist of:
 - a) Qualifying days will be held on Monday 7, 14 and 21 August, 2017 commencing at 18:00:00 and will take place every ten (10) minutes concluding at 21:00:00 (each day a "**Qualifying Day**") in The Suite, level 2 ("**Tournament Location**"). A total of fifty-four (54) Qualifying Day heats will be conducted during the Tournament Period;
 - b) Wild card draw will be conducted on Monday 21 August, 2017 at 21:00:00 ("**Wild Card Draw**") in the Tournament Location in accordance with **Condition 29**;
 - c) Quarter-finals will be held on Monday 28 August, 2017 commencing at 18:30:00 and will take place every ten (10) minutes concluding at 20:00:00 ("**Quarter-final**") in the Tournament Location. A total of ten (10) Quarter-final heats will be conducted during the Tournament Period;
 - d) Semi-finals will be held at 20:30:00 and 20:40:00 on Monday 28 August, 2017 ("**Semi-final**") in the Tournament Location. A total of two (2) Semi-final heats will be conducted during the Tournament Period; and
 - e) Finals will be conducted at 21:00:00 on Monday 28 August, 2017 in the Tournament Location ("**Final**"). A total of one (1) Final heat will be conducted during the Tournament Period.

Participation requirements

3. Participation in the Tournament is open to persons who:
 - (a) are 18 years of age or older;
 - (b) are Members of The Star Club program operated by the Promoter and that have a current Platinum membership card (each a "**Membership Card**");
 - (c) are entitled to access the Tournament Location;
 - (d) are not the subject of an exclusion direction or self-exclusion order pursuant to the Casino Control Act 1982 (Qld);
 - (e) are not the subject of a Withdrawal of Licence (WOL) from The Star Gold Coast or Treasury Brisbane; and
 - (f) receive a Tournament invitation from the Promoter.

People who meet the above criteria are referred to as "**Eligible Members**" and will be entitled to participate in the Tournament.

Tournament registration

4. From Wednesday 5 July, 2017 ("**Mail Date**") onwards, the Promoter will mail Eligible Members an invitation to participate in the Tournament using the records maintained by the Promoter.
5. It is the responsibility of Eligible Members to ensure that they have provided the Promoter with accurate contact details prior to the Mail Date and for the avoidance of doubt, the Promoter will not be liable nor will it take any responsibility in this regard.
6. The Promoter cannot guarantee that invitations will be delivered by Australia Post to Eligible Members prior to the Tournament.
7. The Promoter reserves the right to manually issue an invitation to an Eligible Members provided they meet the criteria in accordance with **Condition 3(a) to 3(e)**.
8. To register for participation in the Tournament, an Eligible Member must contact Treasury's VIP Concierge to reserve their preferred heat date and time. If the preferred heat date or time is unavailable an alternate heat date or time will be determined. In the case that the Tournament is at full capacity, the Eligible Member will be placed on a waitlist and contacted by a representative of the Promoter if a position becomes available by 13:00:00 on Friday 4 August, 2017.
9. Registrations will be accepted in the order in which they are received by the Promoter.
10. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse any persons' participation in the Tournament at any time for any reason whatsoever.

Tournament

11. The Tournament will be open for registration to a maximum of five hundred and forty (540) Eligible Members (each a "**Contestant**").
12. All Contestants will be allocated to a Qualifying Day heat as designated by the Promoter. A minimum of two hundred and sixteen (216) Contestants must participate in the Qualifying Day heats.
13. For each Qualifying Day, Quarter-final, Semi-final heats and Final heat, Contestants will be allocated to a Tournament Electronic Gaming Machine ("**Device**") by order of registration.
14. Upon presenting at the Qualifying Day and Final heats, Contestants must present valid identification, acceptable to a representative of the Promoter in accordance with **Conditions 48 or 49**.
15. Contestants will be permitted to register for more than one Qualifying Day heat if they are unsuccessful in qualifying for a Quarter-final heat and only if there are available positions in future Qualifying Day heats. They may only qualify once for (and therefore only occupy one place in) the Quarter-final, Semi-final and/or Final.
16. All Contestants must participate in the Qualifying Day heats and/or the Quarter-finals, Semi-finals and Final heats as designated by the Promoter.
17. If a Contestant fails to attend a designated heat in time for the start of play, that Contestant will be disqualified from that relevant heat.
18. If the Promoter deems that any of the Devices are malfunctioning and requires removal from the Tournament, the Promoter reserves the right to remove the Device from the Tournament.
19. A Contestant in a Qualifying Day heat or Quarter-final heat or Semi-final heat or the Final heat is unable to complete the specified period of play due to the removal of a Device in accordance with **Condition 18**, the Contestant will be provided with another sixty (60) seconds of play on another allocated Device to determine that Contestant's score for their Qualifying Day heat or Quarter-final heat or Semi-final heat or the Final heat (as applicable).

Qualifying Day

20. At each Qualifying Day, eighteen (18) heats will be conducted (with a maximum of ten (10) and a minimum of four (4) Contestants in each) during the Tournament Period.

21. If less than the maximum number of Contestants that participate in the Qualifying Day heats, the Promoter may (in its absolute discretion) reduce the number of Qualifying Day heats held or the number of Contestant in each Qualifying Day heat.
22. The Contestant playing in the Qualifying Day heat will have the opportunity to register a score ("**Score**") by playing on their allocated Device for a period of sixty (60) seconds in their allocated Qualifying Day heat.
23. The thirty (30) highest Scores from all the Contestants in a Qualifying Day's heats will be eligible to proceed to the Quarter-finals and will be advised of their eligibility by the Promoter after the final heat of the relevant Qualifying Day.
24. If any two (2) or more Contestants have a tied Score at the end of their Qualifying Day heat which would affect the allocation of their place in the Quarter-finals, there will be a sixty (60) second play-off on allocated Devices between those two (2) or more Contestants (a "**Play-Off**"). Devices will be allocated to the Contestants in a Play-Off in the order in which they competed in their Qualifying Day heat.
25. The Contestant who achieves the highest Score in a Play-Off will proceed to the Quarter-final. If more than one (1) position in the Quarter-final must be allocated, Contestants who achieve the highest Scores in the Play-Offs will be allocated a position in the Quarter-final for as many places as are required to be allocated. If any two (2) or more Contestants have a tied score as the result of a Play-Off, further Play-Offs will be held between those Contestants with a tied Score until those Contestants register different Scores. The Score achieved by Contestants in a Play-Off will only be used to determine the ranking of the Scores of those Contestants as between themselves for entry into the Quarter-finals.
26. The Contestants with the three (3) highest Scores in each Qualifying Day heat will receive the following (each a "**Place Winner**"):

 (each a "**Heat Prize**").

27. Each Place Winner will have their Heat Prize added automatically to their Slots Dollar balance. Heat Prizes are not transferable. Slots Dollars may become unavailable due to technical difficulties outside of our control. Heat Prizes are valid thirty (30) days form the day have been awarded.

28. The highest Score from all the Contestant Scores in a Qualifying Day will receive \$2,000 cash.

Wild Card Draw

29. A Wild Card Draw will be conducted from among all the Contestants who were not allocated a position in the Quarter-finals. These Contestants will be automatically enter to the Wild Card Draw. Ten (10) Contestants will be randomly chosen to participate in the Quarter-finals (each a "**Wild Card Entrant**"). A representative of the Promoter will announce the Wild Card Entrant's name and account number in the Tournament Location. If a Wild Card Entrant is not present at the Wild Card Draw, the Wild Card Entrant will be notified by phone or email in accordance with their membership details held by the Promoter. If a Wild Card Entrant refuses to attend Quarter-finals or is not contactable, redraws will occur until ten (10) Wild Card Entrants, who are contactable or who are willing to participate the Quarter-finals, is found.

30. The Promoter does not guarantee that announcements can be heard in all parts of the Tournament Location.

Quarter-final

31. A total of ninety (90) Quarter-finalists and ten (10) Wild Card Entrants will participate in the Quarter-finals (each a "**Quarter-finalist**"). Should a Quarter-finalist fail to attend a Quarter-final heat in time for the start of play, the Promoter reserves the right to conduct the Quarter-finals with less than one hundred (100) Quarter-finalists.

32. Each Quarter-finalist will register a Score in the Quarter-finals by playing their allocated Device for a period of sixty (60) seconds.

33. If any two or more Quarter-finalists have tied Scores at the conclusion of their Quarter-final heat, there will be as many Play-Offs (in accordance with **Condition 24 and 25**) as are needed to determine the ranking of the Scores of those Quarter-finalists as between themselves.
34. The top twenty (20) overall Quarter-finalist Scores from all the Scores in all the Quarter-final heats will be eligible to proceed to the Semi-finals (each a "**Semi-finalist**").
35. The Quarter-finalists who do not proceed through to the Semi-finals through qualification will receive \$250 Casino Dollars. The Casino Dollars will be added automatically to their Casino Dollar balance. These Casino Dollars are not transferable. Casino Dollars may become unavailable due to technical difficulties outside of our control.

Semi-final

36. A total of twenty (20) Semi-finalists will participate in the Semi-finals. Should a Semi-finalist fail to attend their Semi-final heat in time for the start of play, the Promoter reserves the right to conduct the Semi-finals with less than twenty (20) Semi-finalists.
37. Each Semi-finalist will register a Score in the Semi-finals by playing their allocated Device for a period of sixty (60) seconds.
38. If any two or more Semi-finalists have tied Scores at the conclusion of a Semi-final heat, there will be as many Play-Offs (in accordance with **Condition 24 and 25**) as are needed to determine the ranking of the Scores of those Semi-finalists as between themselves.
39. The ten (10) Semi-finalists with the highest overall Scores at the end of the Semi-finals will be eligible to proceed to the Final (each a "**Finalists**").
40. The Semi-finalists who do not proceed through to the Final through qualification will receive \$500 Casino Dollars. The Casino Dollars will be added automatically to their Casino Dollar balance. These Casino Dollars are not transferable. Casino Dollars may become unavailable due to technical difficulties outside of our control.

Final

41. A total of ten (10) Finalists will participate in the Finals. Should a Finalist fail to attend the Final heat in time for the start of play, the Promoter reserves the right to conduct the Finals with less than ten (10) Finalists.
42. Each Finalist will register a Score in the Finals by playing their allocated Device for a period of sixty (60) seconds.
43. If any two or more Finalists have tied Scores at the conclusion of the Final heat, there will be as many Play-Offs (in accordance with **Condition 24 and 25**) as are needed to determine the ranking of the Scores of those Finalists as between themselves.
44. The winner of the Finals will be the Finalist with the highest Score after sixty (60) seconds of play in the Final heat (or any Play-Off's in accordance with **Condition 43**).

Prizes

45. The Finalists will, in accordance to the ranking of the Scores at the conclusion of the Finals or at the end of any Play-Offs needed in the event of tied Scores, receive the following (each a "**Winner**"):

(each a "**Prize**").

46. The first to fourth Winners may choose to take their Prize in cash or a cheque or a combination of both from the Promoter.
47. The maximum total prize pool for the Tournament is \$81,900 made up of \$38,000 cash, \$25,000 Casino Dollars and \$18,900 Slots Dollars.

Identification

48. A Contestant must produce valid acceptable identification to a representative of the Promoter to confirm their eligibility to win a prize. Valid identification acceptable to the Promoter will be either one form of valid photographic identification (Passport or Australian driver's licence) with an undamaged clearly visible photograph, or two other forms of non-photographic identification acceptable to the Promoter.
49. The Promoter reserves the right to waive or vary the identification requirements at its sole discretion in circumstances where the identity of an Eligible Member is determinable by a representative of the Promoter without the assistance of these or any other form of identification.

General

49. Directors, management and employees of The Star Entertainment Group of companies (including any related body corporate as defined in the Corporations Act 2001) and their immediate families are not eligible to participate in this Tournament. For the purposes of this clause, 'immediate families' of an employee means the person's spouse and family members residing at the same premises as the employee. The Star Entertainment Group comprises, but is not limited to the businesses of The Star Sydney, The Star Gold Coast and Treasury Brisbane.
50. Prizes must be taken as stated and cannot be exchanged or redeemed for alternate prizes. Any tax liability or implication which attaches to a prize is the responsibility of the Member claiming that prize.
51. The Promoter is not responsible for any loss, damage or injury suffered or claimed (including, but not limited to, indirect or consequential loss or damage, personal injury or death, and direct or indirect loss or damage) by an entrant in relation to entering or participating in this Tournament or taking or using the prizes offered except where that loss, damage or injury was caused by breach of these terms and conditions by the Promoter or the wilful or negligent acts or omissions of the Promoter.
52. Conduct of the entire Tournament, including decisions on the eligibility of persons to enter and validity of entry and prizes, shall be the responsibility of the Promoter.
53. To the extent that a situation or issue arises for which these terms and conditions make no provision or in relation to which the relevant terms and conditions are unclear, the Promoter reserves the right to decide regarding such situation or issue which is not inconsistent with these terms and conditions.
54. While the Promoter intends to conduct the Tournament as offered, the Promoter reserves the right to cancel or change the Tournament or a prize offered in the Tournament if it can no longer continue the Tournament or offer a prize due to circumstances outside the Promoter's control.
55. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for late or non-received entries. The Promoter does not guarantee the continuous or fault-free operation of the entry processes, including entry validating and receipting processes, during the Tournament.
56. Any entrant who tampers, or attempts to tamper, with the entry processes or tampers, or attempts to tamper with the processes used for the Tournament or who submits an entry which is not valid in accordance with these terms will be subject to disqualification at the discretion of the Promoter.
57. Winners may be asked to participate in publicity or advertising at the request of the Promoter. Participation in any such publicity or advertising is at the sole discretion of the relevant Eligible Member. The names of Winners will not be published without their consent except as announced at the Tournament Location.
58. Participation in the Tournament indicates acceptance of the terms and conditions governing the Tournament. These terms and conditions will be available at The Star Club Desk or at the VIP Services Desk throughout the Tournament Period.
59. By participating in this Tournament, the information provided by an entrant to the Promoter becomes the property of the Promoter and may be used for the Promoter's business analysis and marketing purposes in

accordance with the Promoter's privacy statement which can be viewed at www.treasurybrisbane.com.au. Privacy law allows Members to access their personal information held by the Promoter in certain circumstances. Failure to supply the personal information requested may result in an entry being deemed invalid.
