The colourful wheel will catch your eye and set you spinning. Being one of the fastest and most popular games in the casino, The Wheel always draws a crowd.

THE AIM OF THE GAME

The aim of playing The Wheel is simply to guess on which symbol or number The Wheel will come to rest. The Wheel is divided into 52 segments. These are comprised of seven different symbols of varying odds.

COME FOR A SPIN

The table layout duplicates the symbols and numbers depicted on The Wheel itself. The payout odds and maximum bets are displayed on the table. You may place bets on any symbol. To do so, simply position your chips clearly within the symbols of your choice.

Once all bets have been placed, the Dealer will call "no more bets" and spin The Wheel.

A minimum three revolutions of The Wheel is required for a legal spin. When The Wheel has come to rest, the Dealer will call the winning symbol and number, and pay the winning bets. If the indicator does not fall clearly within one of the segments, the symbol that last passed the indicator will be declared the Winner.

THE ODDS OF WINNING

Another game of chance, The Wheel is divided into 52 compartments, each showing one of the seven different symbols. Players bet on a symbol and win if The Wheel stops on that symbol. The House margin is 7.7% for all symbols and cannot be reduced.
